We are busy fixing some problems with inside of Roseberry Park, our hospital in Middlesbrough.




We have helping people look after their weight and think about what they eat so they can be more healthy.

We also have **members**.


Members are people who have signed a form to say they are interested in the things we do.

In March 2018 we had more than 9,485 public members and more than 6,747 staff members.




We listen to what our members have to say and help them get involved in what we are doing.
